### SEMESTER COURSES

Semester courses are the most intensive courses offered by the Language Department. Classes are Monday through Friday 5 hours per day.

Students may choose classes that most correspond to their needs from the variety of classes offered. Students may choose from one class to all of the offered classes. Take into consideration that the price will not change if you decide to enroll in less of the total number of classes offered.

### MONTHLY AND SUMMER COURSES (AUTHORIZATION)

Students are required to register with the university at least three or four weeks prior to the beginning of classes. They will let the student know if it is possible or not to open it.
